Universal Funding for 3 & 4 year olds

All children aged 3 and 4 are entitled to 15 hours funded childcare support per week for a maximum of 38 weeks per annum, starting from the term after their third birthday.

To be eligible for the 15 hours funding your child must attend the nursery for the minimum hour requirements applicable to the age of your child (see below).

Please note:

- 15 hours funded places are **only** available for children attending a minimum of 3 x full days (8.00am-6.00pm) or 5 x mornings (8.00am-1.00pm)

A maximum of 38 weeks funding is available per year. The funding is to cover the cost of providing 15 hours of free, high quality, flexible childcare. It does not cover the additional hours, snacks and meals, consumables, activities and additional materials, trips, guest visits and other items that make up our enhanced nursery provision.

Full fees will be payable for unfunded weeks provided during the year.

Basis of Charges

- Fees are calculated over 35.2 academic weeks this year for Term Time Only children. In addition, there are 11.2 optional weeks of playscheme. All Year fees include 46.4 weeks of care.
- Dietary requirements and allergies will be accommodated where possible.
- A non-refundable registration fee is payable by all new children.
- Fees are payable in advance either by monthly direct debit on the first day of the month, or termly on the first day of each term, or annually by 1st September each year.
- If payment of fees is not made on the due date then interest of 10% will be added. Where monthly fees are not received by the due date (1st of each month), a late payment charge of £25 per child will be applied to the account. Persistent late payments may result in exclusion.
- For those who enter mid-year, the fees are calculated according to the date of entry.
- There is no reduction in fees if a child is absent due to illness, holiday or adverse weather conditions or for any other reason. In addition, the school will not be in breach of its obligations or otherwise be liable to you by reason of delay in performance or non-performance of its duties due to any event outside of its reasonable control. Such events include, without limitation: fire, war, acts of terrorism, strikes or other industrial action, infectious diseases and epidemics.
- Any request for changes to core hours must adhere to the notice period terms and conditions, one complete term is required in the Pre-Preparatory Department. Repeated requests for changes or fee illustrations will also incur admin charges. Extra hours will be made available as soon as practicable.
- Fees are subject to an increase at the start of each academic year.
- Parents who are not contactable by telephone, in case of a sick child or in an emergency, will be charged £25 after one hour and £25 for every subsequent hour, until they arrive.

- Parents are liable for all costs, fees and charges including any costs reasonably incurred by the school in the recovery of unpaid school fees. The school reserves the right to exclude a pupil on 2 days' notice if fees are overdue for payment to the school, exclusion under these circumstances is not a disciplinary matter for the pupil.

Notice Period

- In the Pre-Preparatory Department, one complete term's notice must be given by letter to the Nursery Manager. A term's written notice means that notice must be given before or on the first day of term and expires at the end of that term. In circumstances where a term's written notice has not been received, fees in lieu of notice at the full applicable rate for the next term will be payable. Provisional notice is only valid for the period for which it is approved and only when provided in writing to the Nursery Manager.

Introductory Discount

- When a current or past family introduces a new family to the school, there is a one-off discount of £1,000 for both families, providing the new child is full time. A pro-rata sum is given based on the hours on starting, if the new child is part-time.
- Only one family can make the introduction and therefore receive the discount. The introducing family's name **must** appear on the Registration Form of the introduced child. If for any reason the new child leaves during the academic year, the discount will be limited to £500 for each full term completed and reclaimed.
- Both families will receive the discount after the new child has completed a full term.

Sibling Discount

- Sibling discount will be applied after any other discounts, funding or reductions have been taken into account but before the annual payment discount.

Other Discounts

- There is a one off bonus discount available to the children moving from Class 4 into Class 5 (at Milton Keynes Preparatory School) of £1,500.

3 to 4 years

- The discount is applied to the annual invoice at the start of the new academic year, if for any reason the child leaves the school during the academic year the discount will be limited to one third for each full term completed. Not applicable for children in receipt of other financial assistance.
- An annual payment discount of 5% is available if fees are paid in full by 1st September each year. The discount will be allowed on the element paid upfront if also paying monthly by childcare vouchers. Annual payment discount is applied after all other discounts and reductions have been taken into account.

These Terms and Conditions are deemed to supersede the Terms and Conditions for the previous academic year.

Your agreement to these terms and conditions is implied when your child starts the new school year from September onwards.

Early Years Funding – 15 hours

From September 2024, the Government introduced 15 hours of funded childcare per week for eligible children aged from +9 months.

A maximum of 38 weeks funding is available per year. The funding is to cover the cost of providing 15 hours of free, high quality, flexible childcare. It does not cover the additional hours, snacks and meals, consumables, activities and additional materials, trips, guest visits and other items that make up our enhanced nursery provision.

Parents must apply and provide an eligibility code to qualify for the 15 hours.

Please note:

- 15 hours funded places are **only** available for children attending a minimum of 3 x full days (8.00am-6.00pm) or 5 x mornings (8.00am-1.00pm)

Full fees will be payable for unfunded weeks provided during the year.

- A non-refundable registration fee is payable by all new children.
- Fees are payable in advance either by monthly direct debit on the **first** day of the month, or termly on the first day of each term, or annually by 1st September.
- If payment of fees is not made on the due date then interest of 10% will be added monthly.
- For those who enter mid-year, the fees are calculated according to the date of entry.
- 15 hours funding is applicable for children aged 0-2 years whose parents meet the eligibility criteria and who attend at least 2 full days per week (8.00am-6.00pm). For more information, please refer to <https://www.gov.uk/get-childcare>, Milton Keynes Council or contact the Bursar.
- Funded places are limited and conditions apply (see below):
 - 15 hours funded places are **only** available for children attending a minimum of 3 x full days (8.00am-6.00pm) or 5 x mornings (8.00am-1.00pm) for 35 or 38 weeks.
- There is no reduction in fees if a child is absent due to illness, holiday and adverse weather conditions or for any other reason. In addition, the school will not be in breach of its obligations or otherwise be liable to you by reason of delay in performance or non-performance of its duties due to any event outside of its reasonable control. Such events include, without limitation: fire, war, acts of terrorism, strikes or other industrial action, infectious diseases and epidemics.
- Any request for changes to core hours must adhere to the notice period terms and conditions, one full month is required for the Nursery Department up to the age of 2. Extra hours will be made available as soon as practicable.

Fees are subject to an increase at the start of each academic year.

The school reserves the right to exclude a pupil on 2 days' notice if fees are overdue for payment to the school, exclusion under these circumstances is not a disciplinary matter for the pupil.

Notice Period

- In the Nursery Department, up to the age of 2, the notice period is one full month given by letter to the Nursery Manager. Failure to give the required notice will result in one month's fees being charged in lieu of notice.

Introductory Discount

- When a current or past family introduces a new family to the school, there is a one-off fees discount of £1,000 for both families, providing the new child is full time. A pro-rata sum is given based on the hours on starting, if the new child is part-time. Only one family can make the introduction and therefore receive the discount.
- The introducing family's name **must** appear on the Registration Form of the introduced child. If for any reason the new child leaves during the academic year, the discount will be limited to a third for each full term completed and reclaimed.
- Both families will receive the discount after the new child has completed a full term.

Sibling Discount

- Sibling discount will be applied after any other discounts, funding or reductions have been taken into account but before the annual payment discount.



Other Discounts

- An annual payment discount of 5% is available if fees are paid in full by 1st September. The discount will be allowed on the element paid upfront if also paying monthly by childcare vouchers. Annual payment discount is applied after all other discounts and reductions have been taken into account.

From 2 to 7+ years children are taught in the Pre-Preparatory Department.

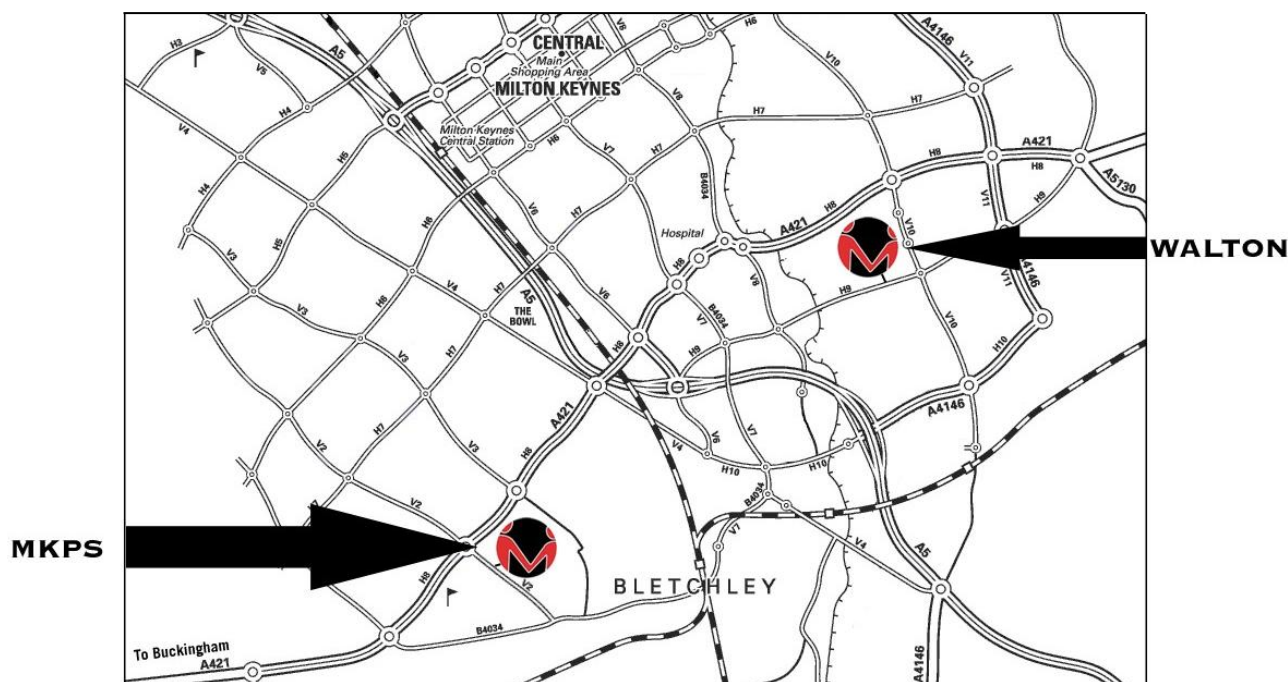
Entry into the Preparatory Department at age 7+ is subject to an entrance examination.

Milton Keynes Preparatory School, in Tattenhoe Lane, MK3 7EG, is situated in south west Milton Keynes, off the Windmill Hill roundabout, where H8 (Standing Way) and V2 (Tattenhoe Street) meet.
